



This website (the “Company Site”) is provided by JRMR Consulting & Services, LLC (the “Company”). Your use of the Company Site is governed by the Terms of Use available at www.JRMRConsulting.com. Your use of the Company Site confirms that you accept and agree to those Terms of Use and this privacy policy and that you agree to the Company’s collection, use and disclosure of your Personal Information as described in this privacy policy. This privacy policy applies to your Personal Information (described below) collected or processed through the Company Site and any Company mobile applications where it is posted.

WHAT PERSONAL INFORMATION WE COLLECT

We receive and store any information you enter on the Company Site or give us in any other way (your “Personal Information”). This Personal Information may include, but is not limited to, your name, address, telephone number, and e-mail address.

Additionally, when you visit the Site, we automatically collect certain information about your device, including information about your web browser, IP address, time zone, and some of the cookies that are installed on your device. Additionally, as you browse the Site, we collect information about the individual web pages or products that you view, what websites or search terms referred you to the Site, and information about how you interact with the Site. We refer to this automatically-collected information as “Device Information.”

We may collect Device Information using any or all of the following technologies:

“Cookies” are data files that are placed on your device or computer and often include an anonymous unique identifier. For more information about cookies, and how to disable cookies, visit www.allaboutcookies.org.

“Log files” track actions occurring on the Site, and collect data including your IP address, browser type, Internet service provider, referring/exit pages, and date/time stamps.

“Web beacons,” “tags,” and “tracking pixels” are electronic files used to record information about how you browse the Site.

WHY WE COLLECT THIS INFORMATION

The Personal Information we collect from you is used for a variety of legitimate business purposes, including without limitation: to respond to your request for services, for provision of such services, to determine your satisfaction with your purchase(s), to administer promotions, to customize our future interactions to meet your needs, to communicate with you, to provide information, and other legitimate business needs. The information about your computer and/or your mobile device is used to analyze marketing statistics, identify trends and continually improve the way in which we serve you.

HOW WE USE THIS INFORMATION

Not surprisingly, much of the value that we provide through the Company Site requires the use of your Personal Information. We use your Personal Information, for example, in the following ways:

- (a) to customize the look and feel of the Company Site for you;
- (b) to internally monitor our customers' usage of the various aspects of the Company Site in order to enhance the products and services that we currently or will, in the future, offer;
- (c) to send you material about topics on which you have requested more information; and

We use the Device Information that we collect to help us screen for potential risk and fraud (in particular, your IP address), and more generally to improve and optimize our Site (for example, by generating analytics about how our customers browse and interact with the Site, and to assess the success of our marketing and advertising campaigns).

While we use information about our users on an aggregated basis and will often share such data with unaffiliated third parties, this information, by its aggregate nature, contains none of your Personal Information. When we refer to an "unaffiliated" third party, we mean one that (i) is not controlled by us, (ii) does not control us, and (iii) is not controlled by the same party controlling us.

WHEN WE DISCLOSE YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

Except as explicitly stated in this privacy policy, we will not disclose to unaffiliated third parties any of your Personal Information without first obtaining your consent. We do and will continue to disclose your Personal Information to unaffiliated third parties in the following circumstances:

- (a) if required by law, regulatory or court order, or legal process;
- (b) if we determine in good faith that doing so would be in the public interest (e.g., if we were to suspect that you were using the Company Site in connection with the commission of a crime or to protect the Company, our customers or employees);
- (c) in connection with a sale, merger, consolidation, change in control, transfer of substantial assets, reorganization, or liquidation of the Company;

(d) if you provide such information to us in connection with a promotion of a good or service offered by a third party, for purposes of such promotion, including, without limitation, sharing such information with that third party;

(e) to provide you with certain services on the Company Site that are provided by such parties, as reasonably required to provide such services;

(f) in the context of working with third-party contractors engaged by us in the provision of the Company Site or related matters;

(g) to conduct investigations of consumer complaints;

(h) to protect the integrity of the Company Site and the Company's products; and

(i) to protect the rights of the Company and those of our customers, including enforcing the Terms governing the use of the Company Site.

After we disclose your Personal Information to unaffiliated third parties in such instances, we can no longer control the use or further disclosure of your Personal Information. Consequently, we will not be responsible to you for such use or further disclosure.

Finally, we may also share your Personal Information to comply with applicable laws and regulations, to respond to a subpoena, search warrant or other lawful request for information we receive, or to otherwise protect our rights.

CORRECTING YOUR INFORMATION

You can ensure that your account information is correct and current by reviewing and updating it at any time. You may do so as often as necessary by sending an e-mail to admin@jrmrconsulting.com, and we will assist you in updating your information.

EMAIL REFERRALS

If you choose to use any website referral function (as may be provided by the Company from time to time) to tell colleagues and peers about the Company Site, you will be required to provide your name and email address and the email addresses of your colleagues and peers. The form automatically sends your colleagues and peers a one-time email inviting them to visit the Company Site. We do not access or store this information, except to send the invitation to visit the Company Site. By using the referral form you are authorizing us to contact others on your behalf and to list your name and email address as the referring party.

SECURITY

We take precautions involving physical, electronic, and managerial controls to protect from loss, misuse, unauthorized access or disclosure, and alteration any of your Personal Information in our possession. We may employ industry-standard Secure Sockets Layer encryption when requesting certain financial Person Information from you. We do not, however, use such encryption during your day-to-day use of the Company Site. You should note that the confidentiality of any information transmitted over the Internet cannot be and is not guaranteed. You should also know that Personal Information collected on the Company Site or otherwise received by the Company from you or third parties may be stored or processed in the United States or any other country where the Company or our service providers maintain facilities (e.g., offices, servers and databases). This Company Site is subject to U.S. laws, which may be different than those of your country. Nonetheless, nothing in this privacy policy deprives you of any of your rights under any applicable and mandatory law. To the extent that any law requires a specific consent related to the collection, storage, processing or use of your personal information, you expressly consent to such collection, storage, processing, and use.

LINKS TO OTHER SITES

You should be aware that this privacy policy applies only to the Company Site. Importantly, it does not apply to any other web or other sites to which a link may be provided as part of the Company Site. We cannot control and are not responsible for the actions of third parties operating such sites. You should not take the existence of an affiliation with, or a link from, the Company Site to any such other site to mean that it has a privacy policy similar to this one.
